😊 COMPONENTE CURRICULAR: PASSADO SIMPLES: VERBOS REGULARES.																										
Os verbos em inglês são classificados como regulares e irregulares, dependendo da conjugação que apresentam. Regra geral, aqueles que seguem uma conjugação padrão de terminações são os chamados verbos regulares. Em sua maioria forma-se o “past tense” dos verbos regulares acrescentando-se ED ou D ao infinitivo: to call → called; to dance → danced.

stop - stopped prefer - preferred	plan - planned shop – shopped																									

2. Os verbos terminados em y precedido de consoante trocam o y por -ied:

study – studied / try - tried

OBS: Quando o y for precedido de vogal, não há mudança ortográfica, bastando apenas acrescentar -ed ao verbo:
play – played / enjoy - enjoyed

He planned to bomb certain buildings, but only the buildings. He wanted to make sure that no one would get hurt. In 1962 he was arrested. He spent 27 years in prison. In 1990 Nelson was released. He was the president of South Africa from 1994 to 1999.

Putin says Covid-19 vaccine approved for use in Russia, despite international safety concerns

bbcnews Vladimir Putin has said a locally developed vaccine for Covid-19 has been approved after less than two months of testing on humans. The Russian President said the vaccine had passed all the required checks, adding that his daughter had already been given it. The country plans to start a mass vaccination in October. However, there is scepticism and concern over the speed with which the vaccine has been developed. Amid fears that safety may have been compromised, the World Health Organization urged Russia to follow international guidelines for producing a Covid-19 vaccine. More than 100 vaccines around the world are in early development, with some being tested on people in clinical trials.
